We have PE sessions every Thursday.

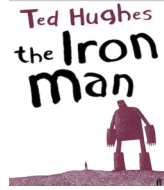
As always, if you have any concerns, worries or observations please do not hesitate to contact us, we are always available.

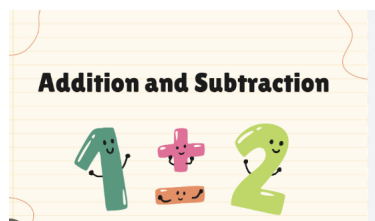
Literacy



In literacy we will be following Jane Considine's Write Stuff lessons helping to develop children's story writing. We are going to finish our work on 'The Blue Umbrella' before moving onto 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes.

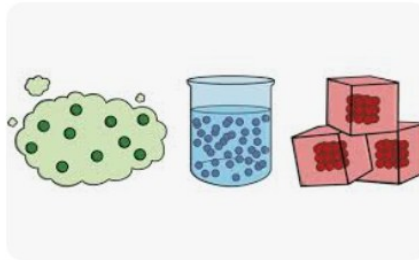
Mathematics

In mathematics we will be focusing on place value before moving onto addition, subtraction and rounding. We will continue to have daily fluency lesson, where we work on a quick recall of timetable and their related division facts.



Science

In science this term, we are continuing studying 'Animals including humans' focussing on types of teeth in humans and their functions. We will then move on to studying 'States of matter', where we will be focussing on solids, liquids and gases and how they are changed.



Geography

This term geography is our main focus. We will focus on physical geography, including: climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts, rivers, mountains and the water cycle.



PE

In PE, we will be focussing on circuit training before moving onto dance.



RE

Within RE, we will be thinking about What kind of world did Jesus want? Next term we are thinking about the question: How do festivals and family life show what matter to Jews?

RSHE

In we will be focusing on 'My beliefs'. We will have discussions about 'How are we the same and different?'

Computing

In ICT the children will start by focussing on internet safety before moving onto photo editing. In term 4, we will be thinking about data collection.



French

We will be learning colours. We will learning how to say what are favourite colour is and creating colour mini books.

ART/DT

In art we will be studying the artist Eileen Agar. We will be creating sculptures and collages.



Music

In music, we will be learning to play musical instruments as part of a group.
