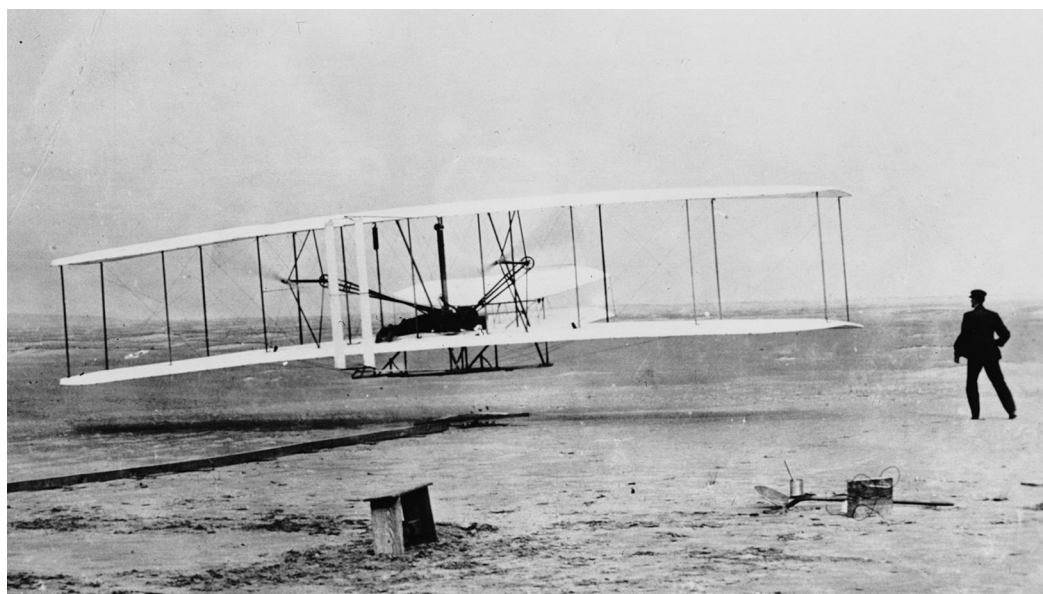

We are using colour semantics to support the children's writing development.

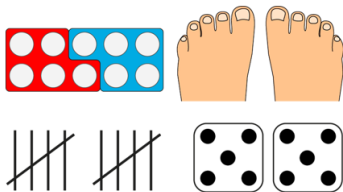

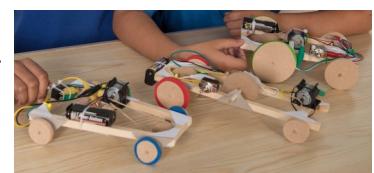
The history of flight, including:

Music

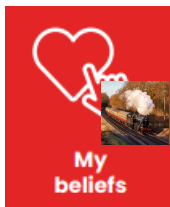
We are learning the grandma rap inspired by transport and composing our own piece of music about trains.
